WHAT IS COMPLETE SYSTEM ANALYSIS, YOU ASK?

The duct work that carries the air from the heat or cool source is the life blood of your comfort system. Craig's Baked Oysters

You'll need:

12 large oysters

34 stick of unsalted butter

2 cloves garlic grated on a micro plane

½ cup julienned baby spinach

3 tsp Finely grated parmesan cheese.

(Do not use shaker cheese)

1 12-hole muffin tin

Preheat oven to 425 Degrees F

Prepare:

Melt butter and add garlic, sautée on low for 5 minutes then turn off, (do not brown), then set aside.

Shuck oysters and remove top shell, place bottom shell with oyster level in muffin tin holes, put 1 teaspoon of butter-garlic mixture in each oyster, put a pinch of spinach in each and ¼ teaspoon of parmesan cheese on top of the spinach.

Put in oven and bake till cheese browns and juices are bubbling, let cool for few minutes and enjoy!
