This year, Comfort Pro, Inc. marks its **25th anniversary**, a milestone that reflects two and a half decades of trusted service.

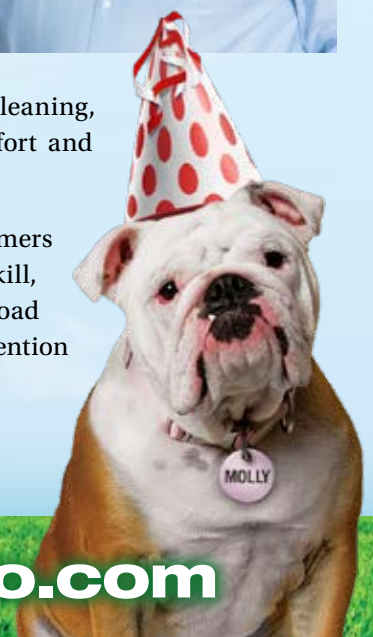

Frozen Watermelon Peanut Butter Dog Treats

When summer temperatures start to climb, our furry friends feel the heat too! These Frozen Watermelon Peanut Butter Dog Treats are a simple, refreshing snack you can make at home to help your pup stay cool.

With only three wholesome ingredients, this recipe is quick to prepare and packed with flavors dogs love. Watermelon helps

keep pups hydrated, Greek yogurt adds a creamy texture and protein, and peanut butter brings that irresistible taste that gets tails wagging.

Best of all, they're easy to make and perfect to keep on hand in the freezer for a cool reward after a walk or playtime in the yard.

Ingredients

- 1 cup plain Greek yogurt (divided)
- 1 cup chopped watermelon
- 2 tablespoons creamy peanut butter

Directions

1. Blend $\frac{1}{2}$ cup yogurt and chopped watermelon in a food processor until smooth.
2. Spoon the mixture into ice cube trays or silicone molds, filling each about halfway.
3. Rinse the processor and blend the remaining yogurt with peanut butter until smooth. Add a splash of water if needed.
4. Pour the peanut butter mixture over the watermelon layer.
5. Freeze for 5 hours or overnight until solid.
6. Pop the treats out of the molds and serve to your happy pup!

Molly's Tip: Always check your peanut butter label. Make sure it does not contain xylitol, which is harmful to dogs. Natural peanut butter with simple ingredients is the safest choice.

Craig's Clam Chowder

You'll need:

- 5 Large potatoes
- ½ Gallon whole milk
- ½ Pint heavy cream
- 36 Chowder clams
- 1 Medium onion
- 3Tbsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1½ Sticks butter
- ¾ Cup flour
- Old Bay seasoning

Prepare:

Mince onion, sauté with ½ stick of butter until clear then set aside. Dice and cook potatoes drain then set aside. Clean and steam clams reserve liquid and strain. Reduce liquid to 2-4 cups. Use food processor to chop clams (do not puree use pulse mode). Combine chopped clams, onions, Worcestershire, butter and broth, simmer for 10 minutes. Add milk and cream to clam mixture. Heat to almost a boil (don't boil it will curdle the milk), Melt 1 stick of butter and add Flour to make a roux. Stir in roux slowly to prevent lumping. Then add cooked potatoes. Adjust thickness by adding more roux if needed. Add Old Bay to taste. Allow time for seasoning to work. DO NOT ADD SALT TO THIS RECIPE!!! (Unless you taste it first.)



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
